In the next couple of decades, we will be able to do things that would have seemed like magic to our grandparents.

This phenomenon is not new, but it will be newly accelerated. People have become dramatically more capable over time; we can already accomplish things now that our predecessors would have believed to be impossible.

We are more capable not because of genetic change, but because we benefit from the infrastructure of society being way smarter and more capable than any one of us; in an important sense, society itself is a form of advanced intelligence. 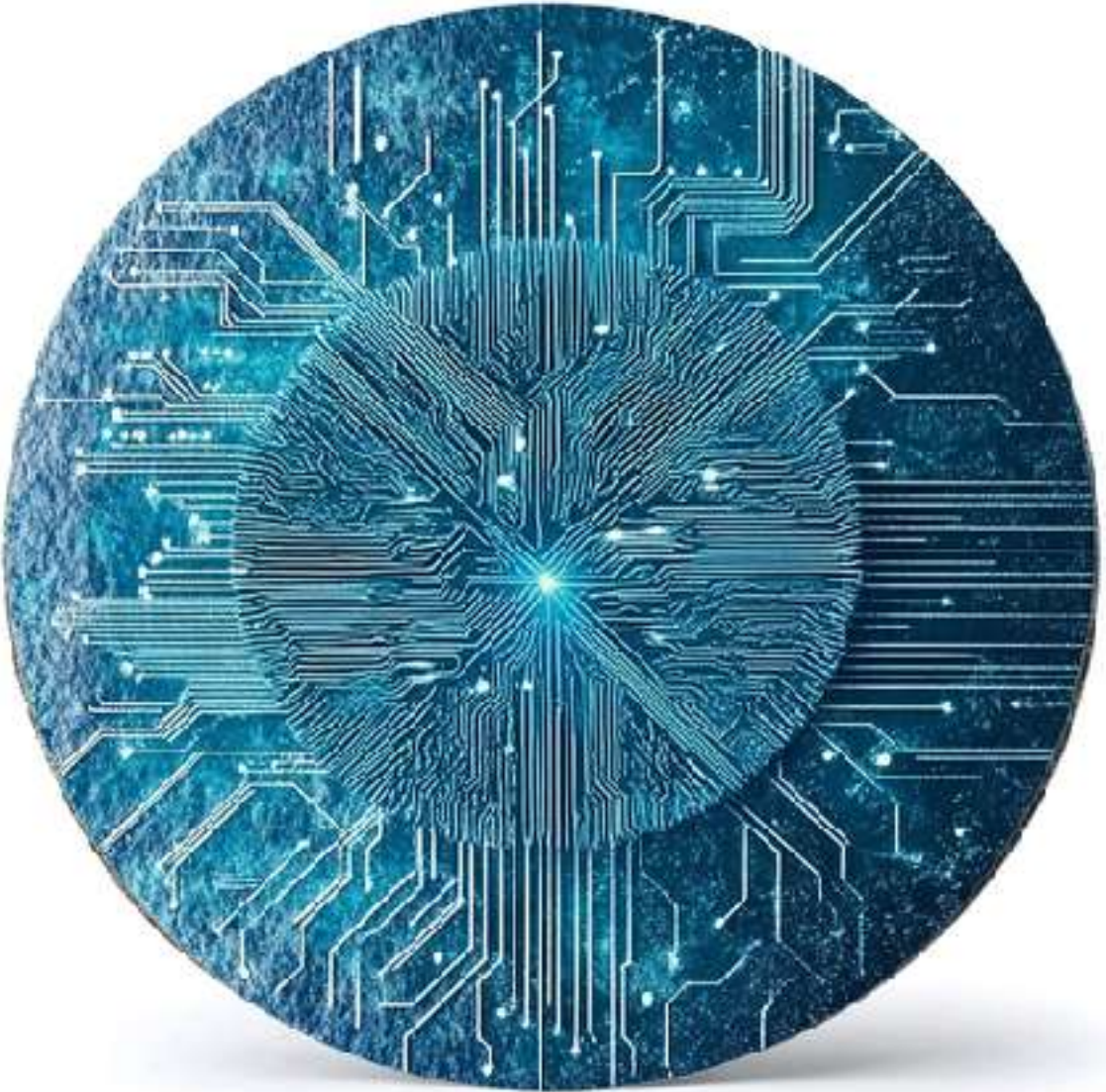

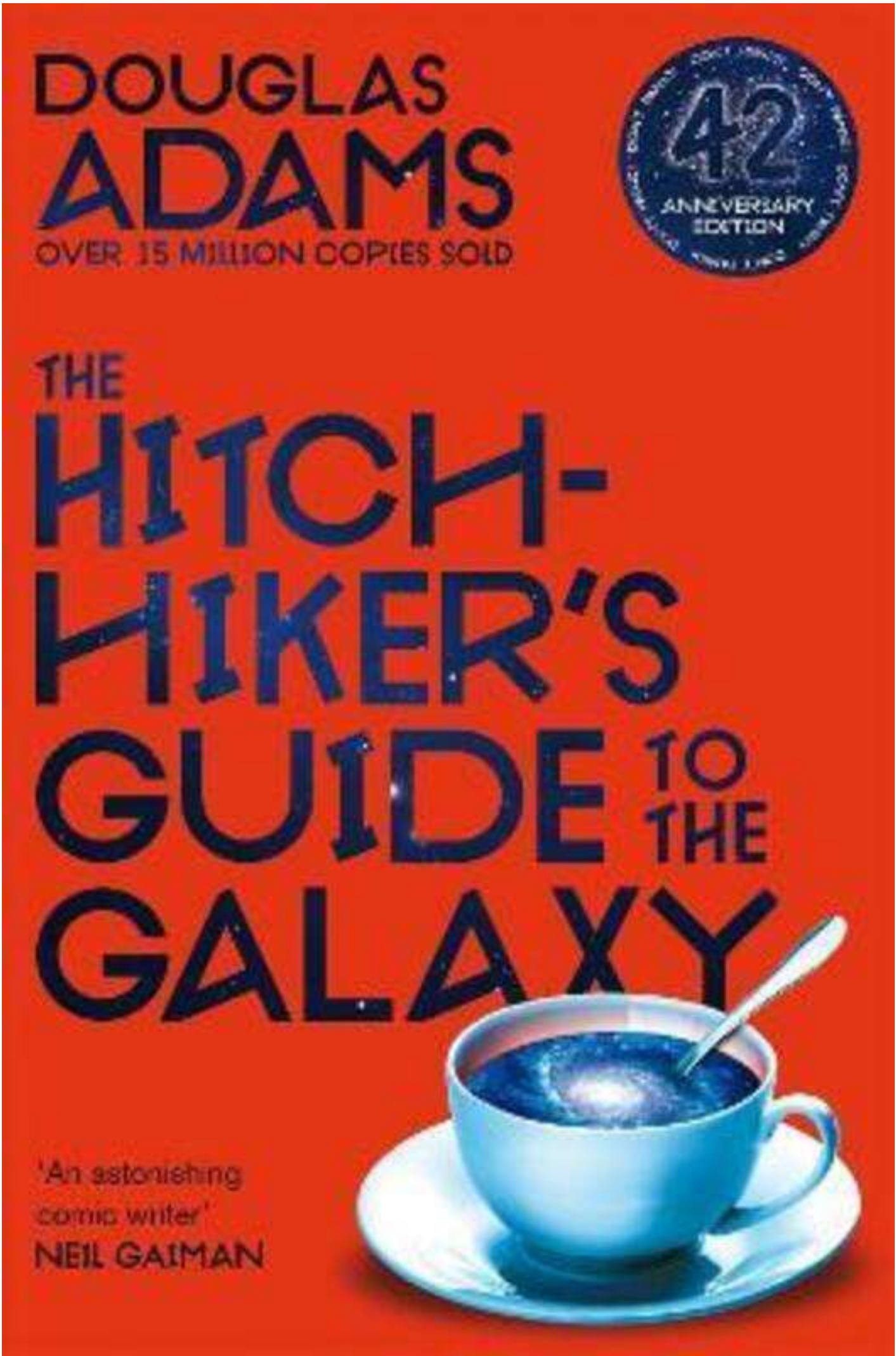

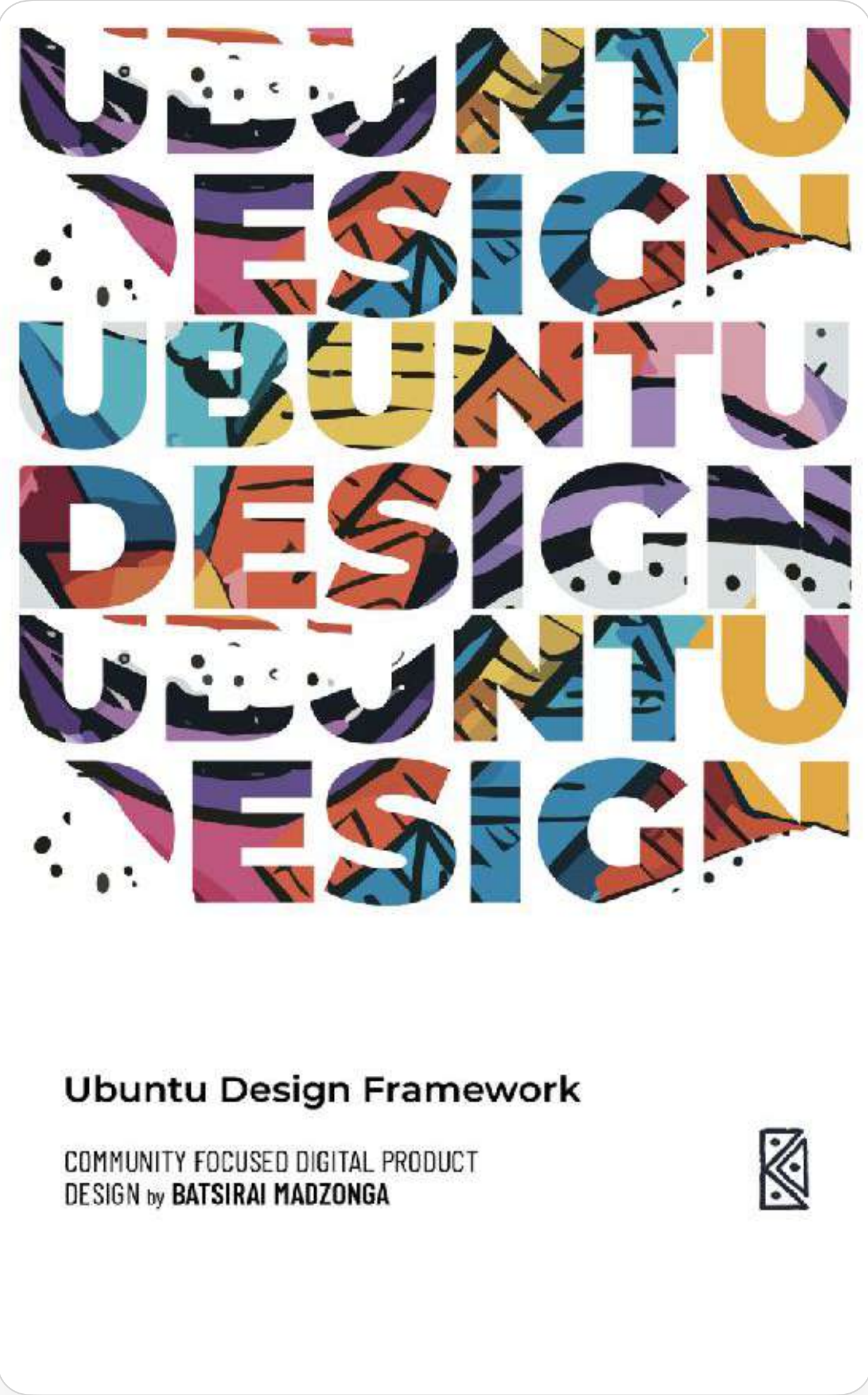

THE PHILOSOPHY

The framework acknowledges the coagency between relationships, community building and product design. This is realised by leveraging concepts from the Afrikan value system Ubuntu.

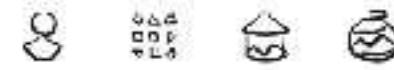


FIGURE 4.1: The four pillars of the UDF philosophical framework



THE PRACTICAL

I call this **Associative Design** – a method where designers deploy nodes based on complexity, preparation time, and their connections. Smaller tasks use low-complexity, low-preparation nodes.

To effectively connect the nodes in Associative Design, it's essential to cultivate specific relationships. This is where the philosophical foundations of the UDF align with its practical applications.

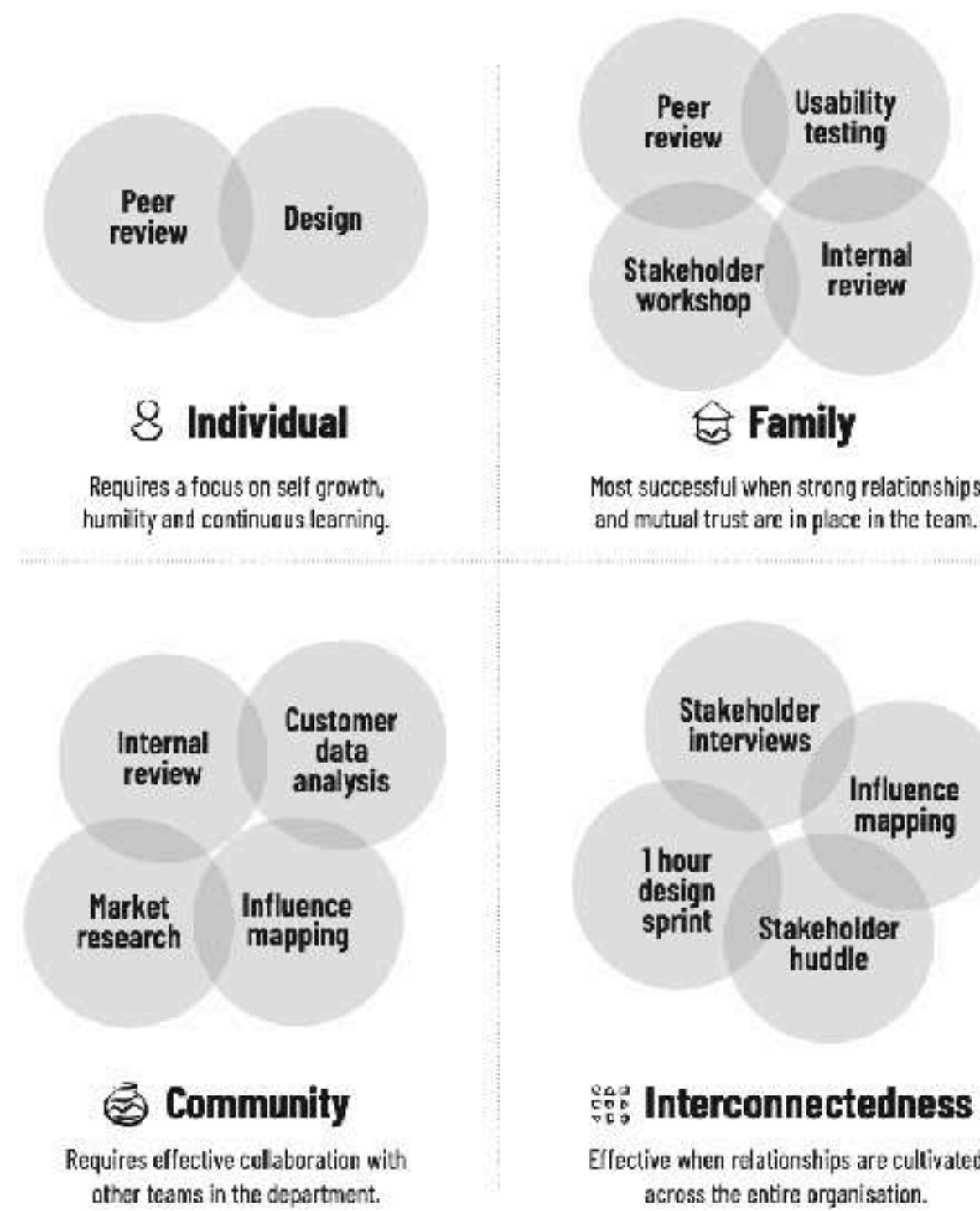


FIGURE 4.4: Relating Associative Design nodes to the UDF philosophical framework

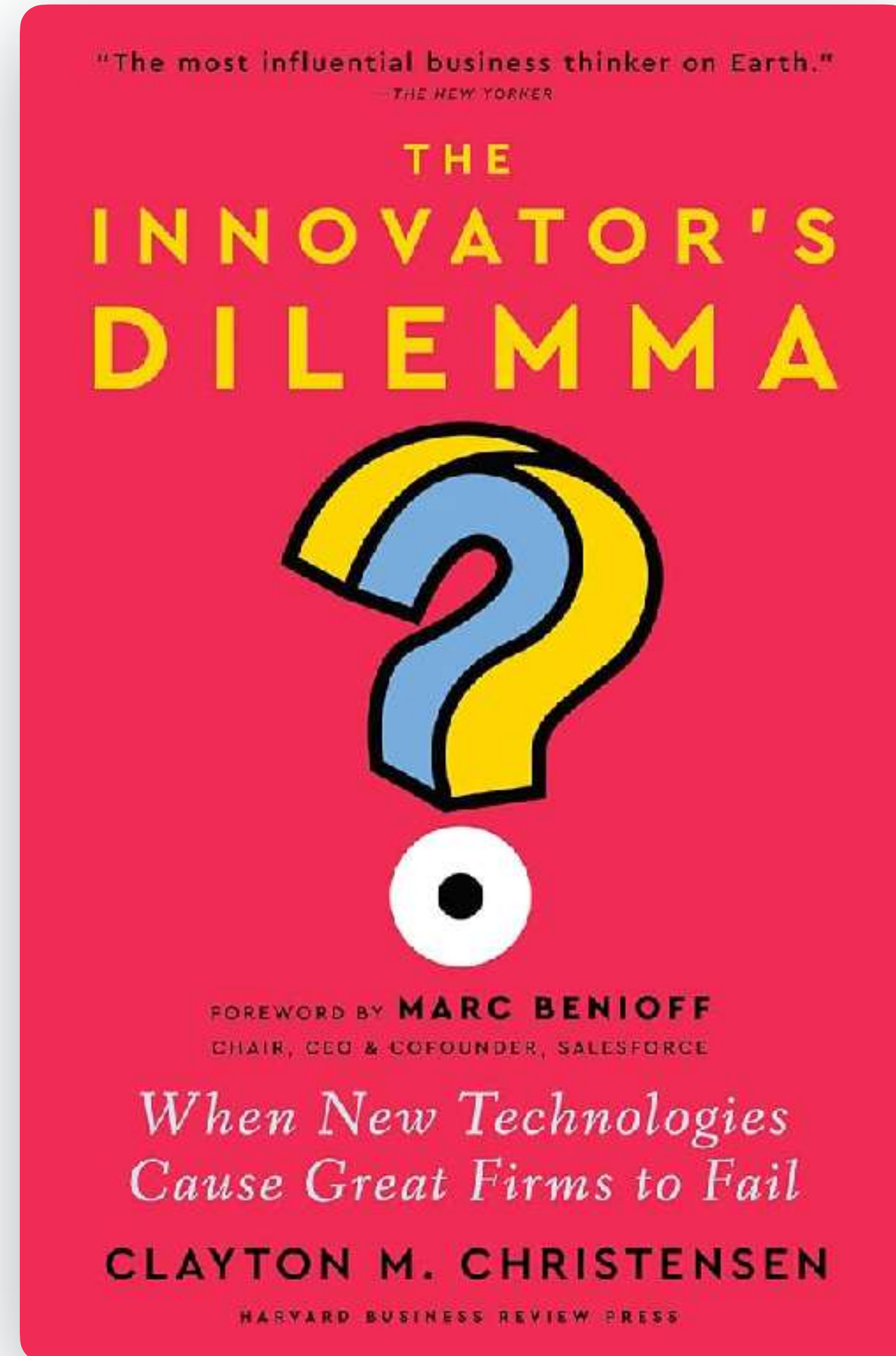

Export Figma variables to iOS, Android and Web formats with Style Dictionary.

- 1 Select a library to detect its Figma Variables.
- 2 Convert them into Style Dictionary friendly JSON format.
- 3 Create a Style Dictionary directory structure and save the JSON into it.
- 4 Run `npm run generate` command to compile the design token JSON into iOS, Android and CSS formats.

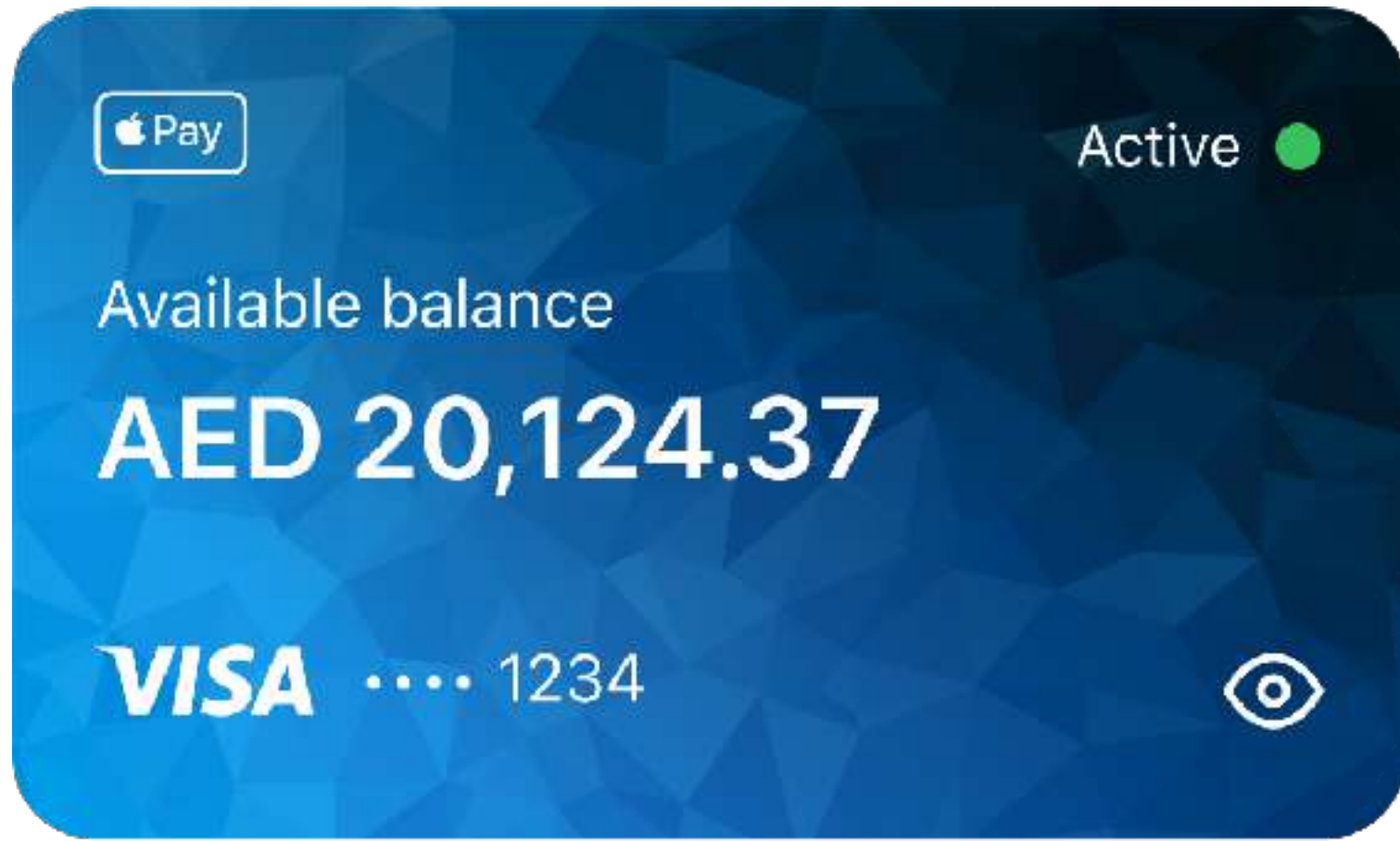

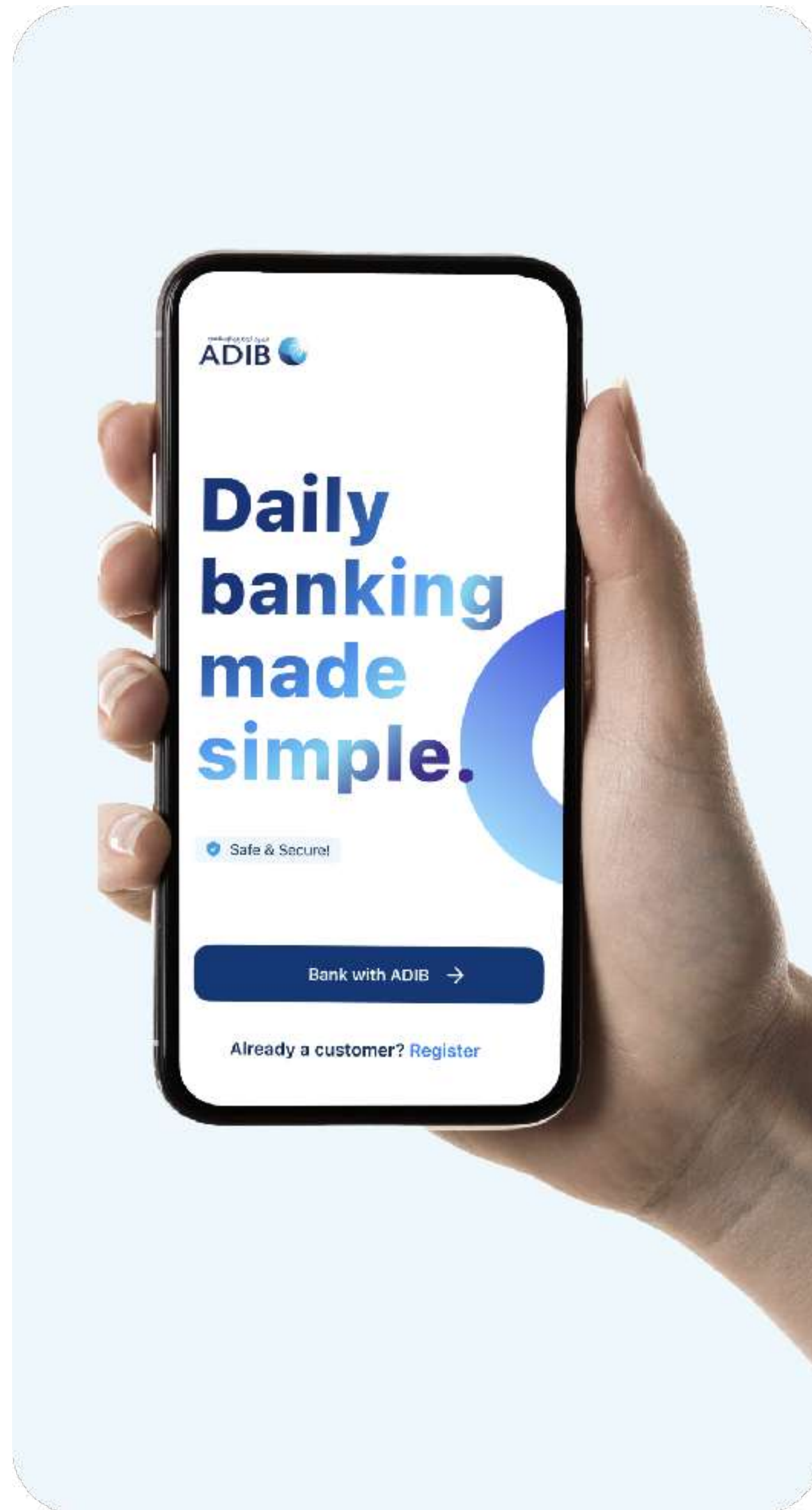
